本周精选与可选级牛胴体综合价差从上周的4.28美元/百磅小幅扩大至4.87美元/百磅，但仍低于去年同期的10.93美元/百磅。

自去年11月初以来，谷饲牛肉产量中，可选级占比持续低于极佳级。截至1月24日当周（最新可用数据），可选级占比仅为9.2%，而极佳级占比达14.5%（精选级为73.2%）。在过去12周的数据中，极佳级占比每周均超过13%，其中有五周超过14%，并在截至1月17日当周创下14.9%的历史纪录。

精选级牛胴体各初级分割部位价格环比变动方面：肋脊（rib）上涨2%，腹腹（short plate）上涨2%，后腿（round）上涨1%，腹肋（flank）上涨1%。腰脊（loin）价格持平，肩胛（chuck）和肩胛（brisket）价格分别下跌2%和3%。

精选级批发去骨眼肉价格在去年11月底的年末假季达到季节性高点14.68美元/磅，随后在年初季节性回调。本周均价为10.62美元/磅，较去年同期及2024年同期均上涨9%。

精选级里脊价格于2025年11月中旬创下20.09美元/磅的历史纪录，随后在2025年底至2026年初同样季节性回落。本周均价为14.12美元/磅，为去年5月中旬以来最低水平，较去年同期上涨11%，与2024年同期持平。

精选级去骨上后腰脊肉价格通常会在烧烤季达到年度峰值，去年7月初曾创下7.58美元/磅的历史新高。去年11月至12月期间价格总体横盘整理，2026年初再度上行。若延续去年走势，价格预计将从当前水平持续上涨至烧烤季峰值。消费者对高性价比部位的偏好对精选上后腰脊部位价格形成支撑，本周均价为5.78美元/磅，较去年同期上涨32%，较2024年同期上涨48%。

50%牛碎肉价格在过去六周持续上涨，本周环比上涨3%至1.56美元/磅，该价格较去年同期上涨50%，较2024年同期上涨79%。

90%牛碎肉本周均价环比上涨0.04美元至4.15美元/磅，为去年10月初以来最高水平，较去年同期上涨12%，较2024年同期上涨38%。由于母牛屠宰量减少导致国内瘦牛肉供应趋紧，而需求保持强劲。进口90%牛碎肉价格于去年11月中旬创下4.01美元/磅的纪录。本周均价环比上涨0.03美元至3.83美元/磅，较去年同期上涨22%，较2024年同期上涨40%。

本周预估牛肉产量为4.775亿磅，环比（#1）增长1.1%，但同比下降6.1%。2026年初至今累计产量较去年同期下降6.0%。

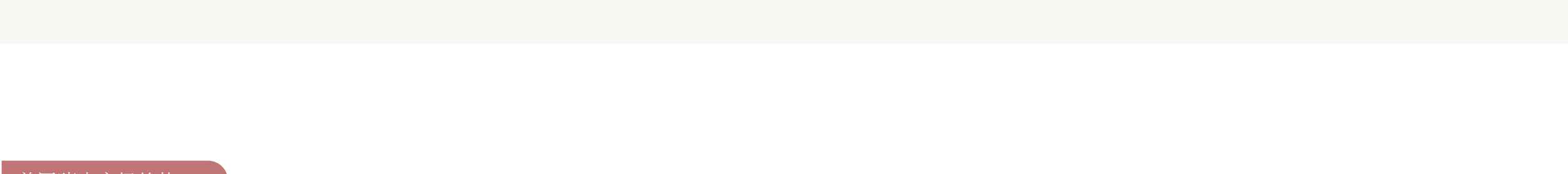
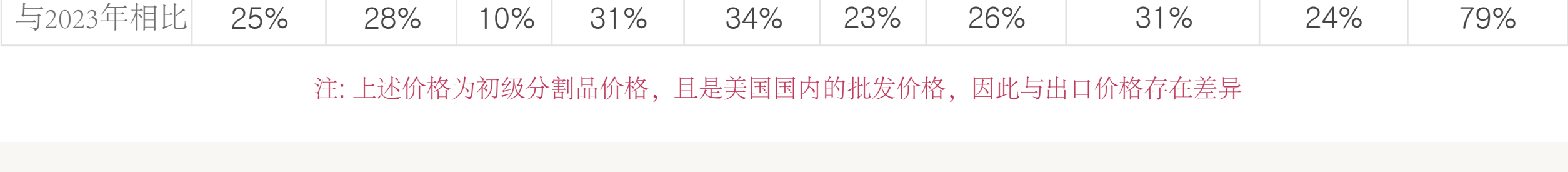
本周预估活牛屠宰量为53.6万头，环比（#2）增长1.5%，但同比下降8.1%。年初至今累计屠宰量较去年同期下降7.9%。

本周活牛宰前均重1.466磅，环比下降5磅，但同比增加26磅；宰后胴体均重893磅，环比下降4磅，但同比增加18磅。

本周活牛现货均价达239.91美元/百磅，较上周五上涨3.17美元/百磅。

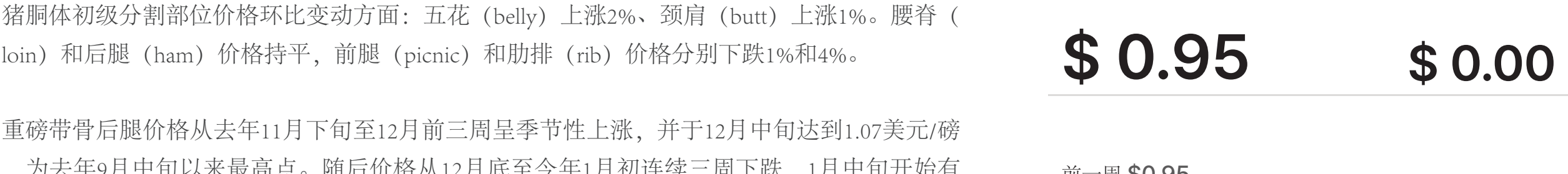

猪胴体综合价在去年12月底至今年1月上旬走底后，自1月中旬起至上周持续反弹。本周价格环比和同比均持平，为0.95美元/磅，较2024年同期上涨10%。

猪胴体初级分割部位价格环比变动方面：五花（belly）上涨2%，颈肩（butt）上涨1%。腰脊（loin）和后腿（ham）价格持平，前腿（picnic）和肋排（rib）价格分别下跌1%和0%。

重磅带骨后腿价格从去年11月下旬至12月前三周呈季节性上涨，并于12月中旬达到1.07美元/磅，为去年5月中旬以来最高点。随后价格从12月底至今年1月初连续三周下跌，1月中旬开始有所反弹。但近两周价格再度走低，本周环比微跌0.3%至0.85美元/磅，该价格较去年同期上涨12%，较2024年同期上涨18%。带骨后腿价格通常在复活节前会再次季节性上涨。

今年以来，现货箱装去骨后腿肉价格因交易量清淡持续波动。圣诞节前三周交易量较大，随后在12月最后两周（均含假日）及1月有所放缓。本周交易量为6.1万磅，高于上周的4.1万磅及两周前的4.9万磅。本周价格在1.40至2.11美元/磅区间波动，均价为1.49美元/磅，环比下跌5%，该价格较去年同期上涨4%，较2024年同期上涨24%。

本周预估猪肉产量为5.703亿磅，环比（#1）增长3.5%，同比上涨0.4%。

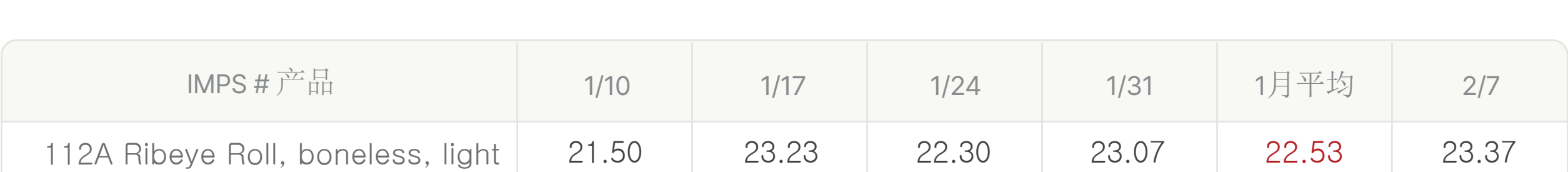
本周生猪屠宰量为259.3万头，环比（#2）增长3.7%，同比增长2.9%。

本周生猪宰前均重295磅，环比持平，同比增加13磅；宰后胴体均重220磅，环比持平，同比增加5磅。

本周生猪现货均价为85.39美元/百磅，较上周五上涨1.82美元/百磅。

本周瘦肉猪期货合约成交价如下：26年2月合约87.38美元/百磅（较上周五上涨0.13），26年4月合约97.95美元/百磅（上涨2.80），26年5月合约101.28美元/百磅（上涨2.35），26年6月合约110.60美元/百磅（上涨2.67）。

U.S. beef market trends

U.S. Beef Market Trends

The Choice beef cutout reached a record high of \$4.14/lb. the first week of September. Prices decreased for nine consecutive weeks from the beginning of November through early January, but the Choice cutout then trended higher for four weeks through last week. This week, the Choice cutout edged up just 0.2% from last week to an average of \$3.69/lb., which was the highest since late November. Prices were up 13% from last year and up 25% from last year as prices continue to be supported by record domestic demand and lower production levels.

The Choice/Select spread widened from \$4.28/cwt last week to \$4.87/cwt this week. The Choice/Select spread was down from \$10.93/cwt last year.

The share of fed beef production grading Select has been lower than the share grading Prime since the beginning of November. For the week ending Jan 24 (the latest available data), the Select grading percent was only 9.2% compared to 14.5% for Prime (and 73.2% for Choice). The Prime grading percentage has been above 13% every week for the past 12 weeks of data, and during that time period, the share of fed beef production grading Prime was over 14% for five weeks (and hit a record 14.9% for the week ending Jan 17).

Compared to last week, values increased for the Choice rib (+2%), short plate (+2%), round (+1%), and flank (+1%) primals. The Choice loin primal value was steady, and prices trended lower for the Choice chuck (-2%) and brisket (-3%) primals.

The seasonal price high for the end of the year holidays was \$14.68/lb. at the end of November for Choice wholesale boneless ribeye prices. Prices adjusted seasonally lower early in the year, and this week, prices averaged \$10.62/lb., up 9% from last year and up 9% from 2024.

Choice tenderloin prices reached a record \$20.09/lb. in mid-November before also adjusting seasonally lower at the end of the year and in early 2026. This week, prices averaged \$14.12/lb., the lowest since mid-May and up 11% from last year but steady with 2024.

Choice boneless top butts peak during grilling season and last year reached a record high of \$7.58/lb. at the beginning of July. Prices moved mostly sideways from November through December but are trending higher again in early 2026, and prices follow the same pattern as last year, they will continue to trend higher from now until the grilling season peak. This week prices reached \$5.78/lb., up 32% from last year and up 48% from 2024 as prices were supported by demand for value options.

Prices for 50% beef trim have been trending higher over the past six weeks, and this week, prices increased by 3% to an average of \$1.56/lb., which was up 50% from last year and up 79% from 2024.

90% beef trim prices averaged up \$0.04 from last week to \$4.15/lb., which was the highest since early October. Prices were up 12% from last year and up 38% from 2024. Demand remains strong and supplies are tighter for domestic lean beef due to smaller cow slaughter. Imported 90% beef trim prices reached a record \$4.01/lb. in mid-November. Prices edged up \$0.03 from last week to an average of \$3.83/lb. this week, which was up 22% from last year and up 46% from 2024. Imported beef trim from countries except Mexico and Canada had been subject to an additional reciprocal duty of at least 10% since April, but in mid-November, President Trump dropped the immediate removal of reciprocal tariffs on beef (among other select products), so 90% lean imports no longer have an additional tariff.

Weekly estimated beef production was 477.5 million lbs., up 1.1% from last week (#1) but down 6.1% from last year. 2026 year-to-date production was down 6.0% from last year.

Weekly estimated slaughter was 536,000 head, up 1.5% from last week (#2) but down 8.1% from last year. Year-to-date slaughter was down 7.9% from last year.

Live weights averaged 1,466 lbs., down 3 lbs. from last week but up 26 lbs. from last year. Dressed weights averaged 893 lbs., down 4 lbs. from last week but up 18 lbs. from last year.

Cash steer prices were up \$4.81 from the previous week. This Friday, cash prices averaged \$239.91/cwt, up \$3.17/cwt from last Friday.

Live cattle futures contracts traded at: February: \$237.75 (+\$1.90 from last Friday), April: \$237.25 (+\$0.45), and June: \$233.85 (+\$2.15).

From January 23 to 29, 2026, U.S. beef exports increased 3% from the previous week to 12,992 tons, of which exports to China was 0.

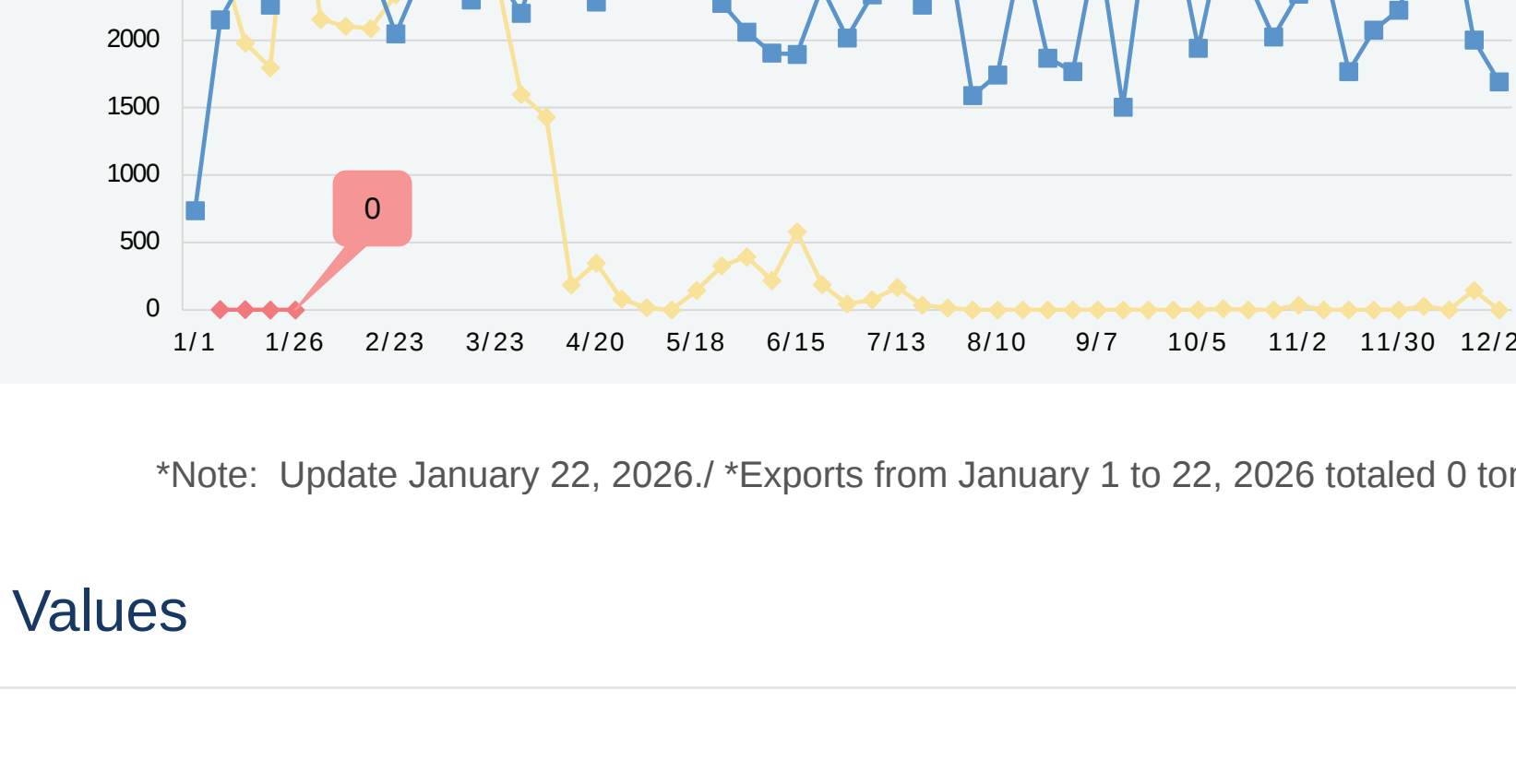

U.S. pork market trends

U.S. Pork Market Trend

After trending lower from late December through early January, the pork cutout trended higher from mid-January through last week. This week, the cutout held steady with last week at an average of \$0.95/lb., which was steady with last year and up 10% from 2024.

Compared to last week, values increased for belly (+2%) and butt (+1%) primals. The loin and ham primal values were steady, while values decreased for the picnic (-1%) and rib (-4%) primals.

Heavy bone-in ham prices trended seasonally higher from late November through the first three weeks of December and reached \$1.07/lb. in mid-December, which was the highest since mid-September. Prices then decreased for the last three weeks from late December through early January before starting to rebounding somewhat in mid-January. However, prices have been trending lower for the last two weeks, and prices edged down 0.3% this week to an average of \$0.85/lb., which was up 12% from last year and up 18% from 2024. Prices typically increase again seasonally ahead of Easter.

As has been reported this year, spot boneless, boxed rollout ham prices have been volatile on thin trading volumes. Volumes were large for the three weeks ahead of Christmas before slowing during the last two weeks of December (which both included holidays) and in January. This week, the trading volume was 61,000 lbs., up from 41,000 lbs. last week and from 49,000 lbs. two weeks ago. Prices traded in a range between \$1.40 and \$2.11/lb. this week for an average of \$1.49/lb., which was down 5% from last week. This week, prices were up 4% from last year and up 24% from 2024.

Weekly estimated pork production was \$70.3 million lbs., up 3.5% from last week (#1) and up 4% from last year.

Weekly hog slaughter was 2,593 million head, up 3.7% from last week (#2) and up 2.9% from last year.

Live weights averaged 295 lbs., steady with last week and up 3 lbs. from last year. Dressed weights averaged 220 lbs., steady with last week and up 2 lbs. from last year.

Cash hog prices averaged \$85.39/cwt, up \$1.82/cwt form last Friday.

The further out lean hog futures contracts traded at: February: \$87.38 (+\$0.13 from last Friday), April: \$97.95 (+\$2.80), May: \$101.28 (+\$2.35), and June: \$110.60 (+\$2.67).

From January 23 to 29, 2026, U.S. pork exports increased 5% from the previous week to 37,622 tons, of which exports to China was 3,037 tons, up 16% from the previous week.

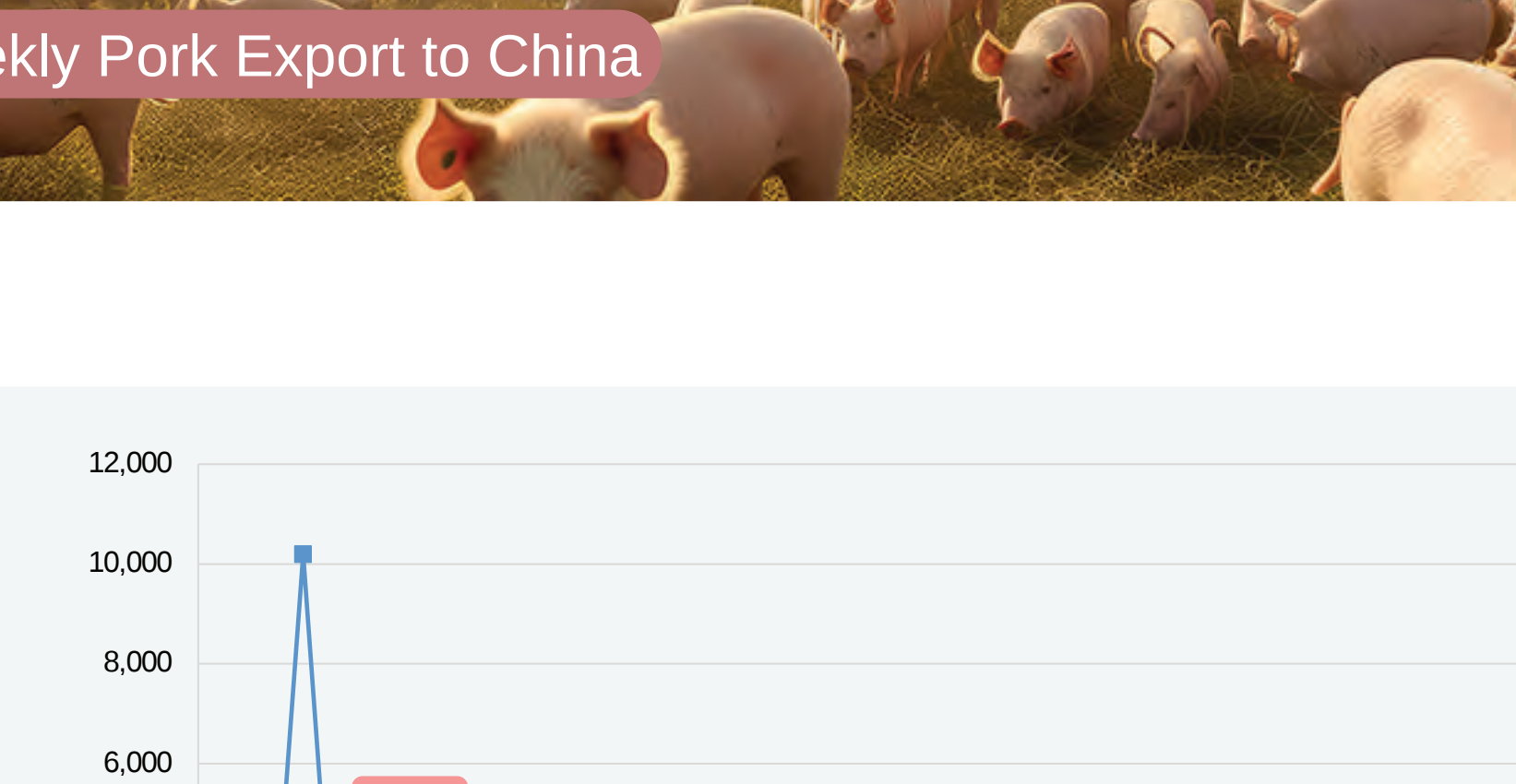

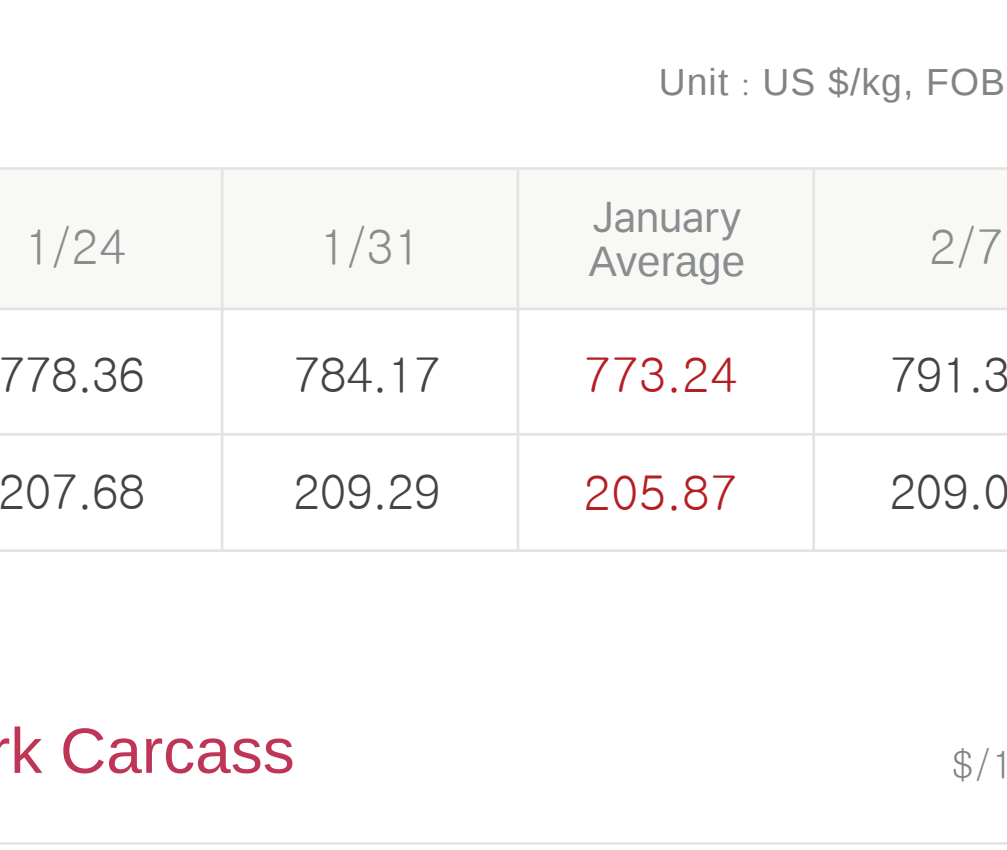
Beef Carcass

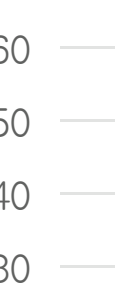
Pork Carcass
